 - High Acuity, represents the most severely mentally ill clients within the county
 - LPS Conserved clients, including Murphy conserved
 - Continuous collaboration; forensics team, clinics, PG'S office, Stakeholders, Family, hospitals, judicial team



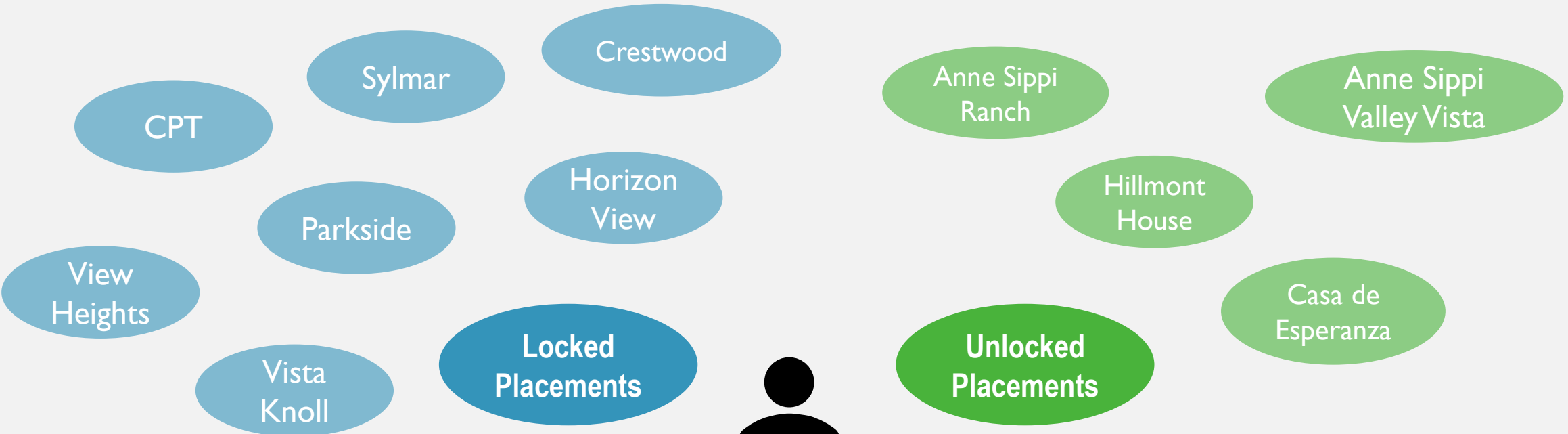

- The ARS team consists of 8 staff who monitor our clients' progress:
 - Assessing the clients
 - Ensure treatment plans are viable
 - Engaging with clients, their families, their conservator (if conserved)
 - Transporting clients with an eye on placing clients in the least restrictive environment
 - If out of county move them back to Ventura County whenever possible.

- EPICS is a FSP (Full-Service Partnership) program for high acuity clients, many of whom have stepped down from higher levels of care to independent living or Board & Care facilities in Ventura County
- Maximum cliental of 80 with a team of 7 staff; clinicians, case managers, nurses and a psychiatrist available to provide intensive oversight
- Clients are seen weekly by staff and are often called on daily to monitor and render aid
- Based loosely on ACT (Assertive Community Treatment), the EPICS team works together to provide Mental Health Services and assist clients in health care navigation
