Ms. Manakas highlighted the continuing effort of the school in suicide prevention. 1,046 students and 70 employees were trained in Suicide Prevention Training. These trainings are primarily QPR Gatekeeper’s Training and others using Kognito at Risk Trainings. The school also conduct Mindfulness Training to students. 3.
