Zoom Participation Information

Please note the following important information related to supporting your participation in the upcoming meeting:

1. The meeting will be recorded, preceded by an announcement to alert attendees when recording will begin.
2. Upon joining Zoom, everyone will be “admitted” into the “**waiting room**,” after which VCBH support staff will gradually admit each attendee into the meeting space.
3. All participants will be muted upon entry to minimize any unintended disruption by background sounds.
4. During the 'Public Comments' portions of the agenda, participants will be unmuted and able to comment for up to 3 minutes (following County policy). Joining the queue to make a comment can be done in the following ways:
 - a. If you are joining the meeting via video/audio, you can join the comment queue by opening the participant window at the bottom of the zoom screen, and then clicking on the “**Raise Hand**” feature in the participant window. Alternately, at the bottom of the main window might be a “**Reactions**” option. Click on it and there will be a “**Raise Hand**” option. Click it.
 - b. If you are joining the meeting by telephone only, you can join the comment queue by pressing *9. Once given the opportunity to speak, telephone attendees will need to press *6 to unmute themselves.
5. Speakers will be recognized in the order they are received by the zoom program and automatically placed into a virtual queue to speak. The host will state the name of each person when it is his/her/their turn to speak. Each speaker will then be unmuted to allow for comments.
6. Most comments are allotted up to 3 minutes, per County policy. The host will notify the speaker as he/she/they approach/es the end of the three minutes. Once notified, the speaker is asked to make a closing comment, and will again be muted. The next speaker in the queue will then be unmuted and able to comment.
7. **Every effort is made to welcome each participant and ensure he/she/they feel/s respected and given a fair opportunity to participate and be heard and understood. Please notify the Chair if you have any concerns.**
