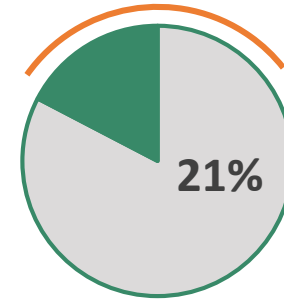
The impact on a child is severe and lasts a lifetime.

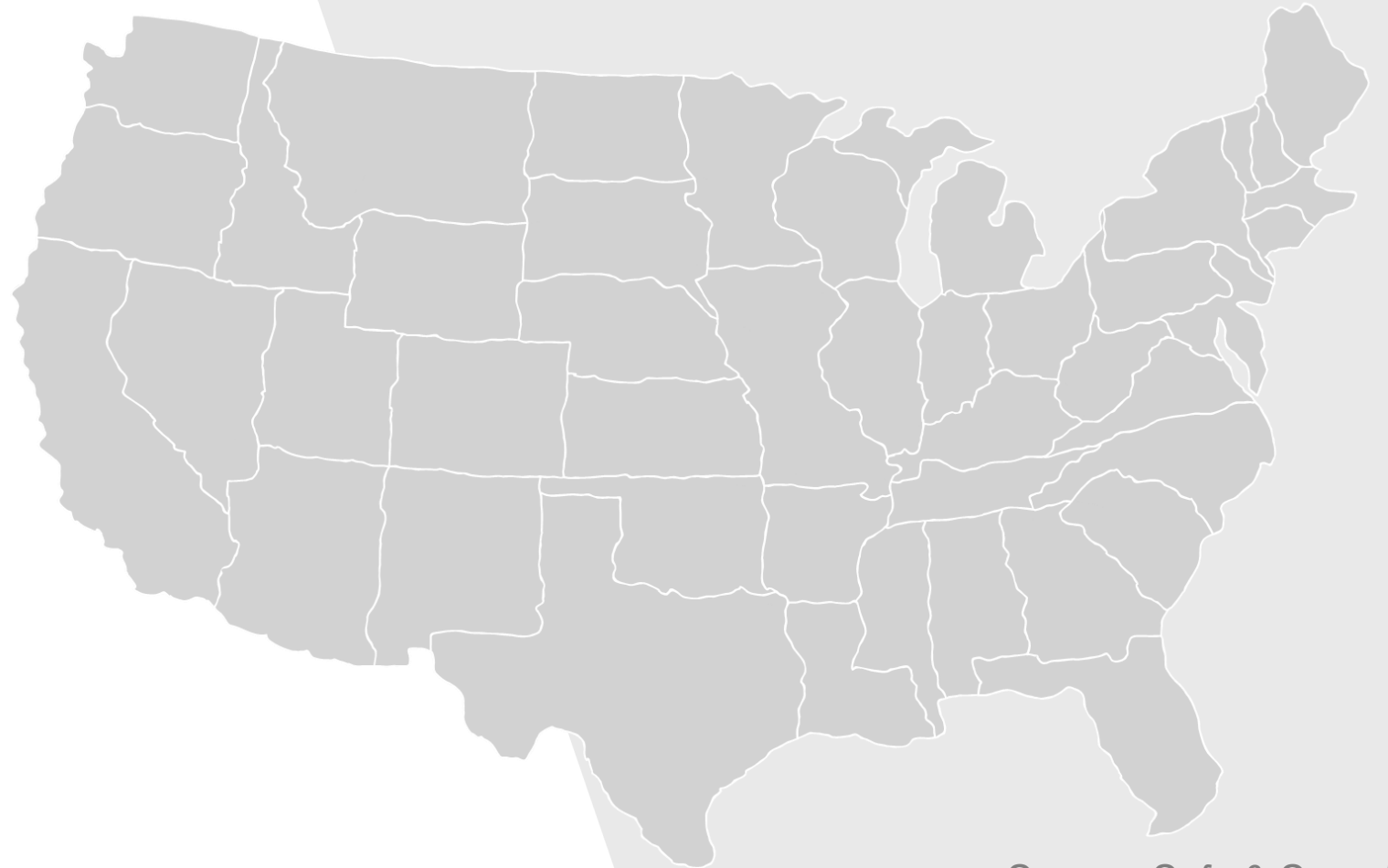

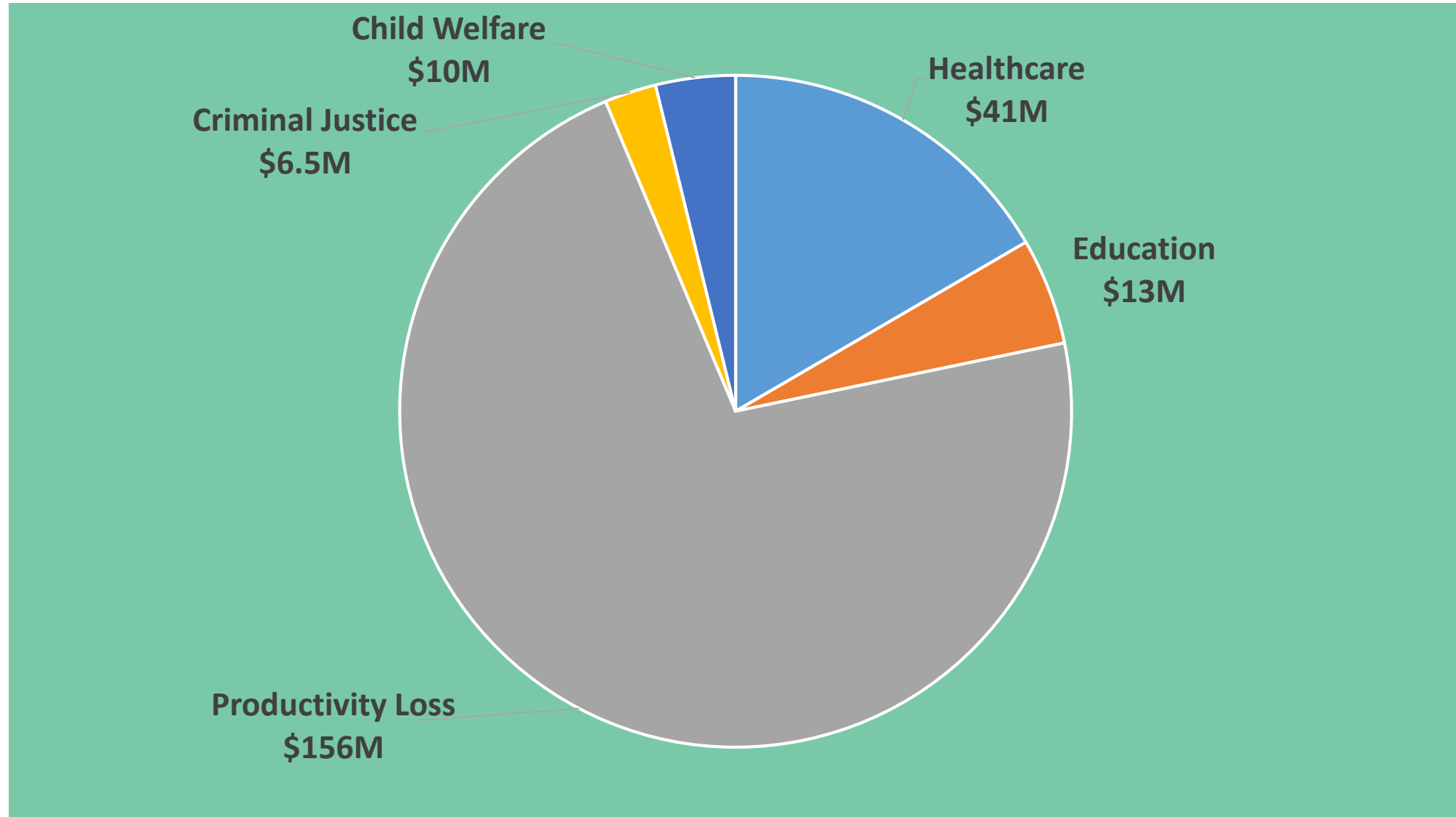

Prevention of child abuse

- Begins with *promotion* of child and family well being across systems
- Focus on the social determinants of health
- Promote resilience in families to addresses drivers that lead to stress, instability and safety concerns in families



National & State Movement



- Commission to Eliminate Child Abuse and Neglect Fatalities
 - Focus on Primary Prevention
- 21st Century Child and Family Well-Being System
 - Reimagine Child Welfare
- Family First Prevention Services Act
 - Flexibility with Title IV-E dollars; Keep Families Intact

National & State Movement (cont.)



- Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Summit
 - 23 Cross-Collaborative Teams Begin Prevention Planning
- CalAIM
 - Behavioral Health Reform
- California's First Office of the Surgeon General
 - Reduce ACEs by 50% in One Lifetime

 - full continuum approach to AB 2083
- Fundamental in addressing race, equity and inclusion

E4C VC Purpose



Align government, community and family stakeholders to maximize wellness and quality of life so all children, and their families, are safe, healthy, educated and well with a sense of belonging, purpose and opportunity to achieve their aspirations.

E4CVC members will champion and accomplish such changes through policy, program and practice alignment throughout the entire continuum of health and human services, and also through neighbor-to-neighbor reciprocity.

E4C VC Objectives



- Strengthen and expand the effectiveness, efficiency and equity of the health and human services across the continuum as well as community opportunities for success provided to all Ventura children and their families
- Cross sector, community engagement to identify and prioritize the complex community problems/issues that impact multiple systems
- Generate the ideas, innovation and public will to improve the access, outcomes and quality of care (to be further defined by members) for the children and their families

AB 2083 - Mandate

Requires counties to develop system of care and MOU to serve children with the highest level needs

Required Partners:

- BH, CFS, Probation, Education, Regional Center

11 Required Domains:

- leadership, ICPM, data sharing, entry, teaming, placement, care coordination, HR, financial, dispute resolution, foster care

Aligns with ICMC process



AB 2083 - Opportunity

Begins “upstream” – with children and families BEFORE their needs become acute

Starts with promotion of child and family well-being, building protective factors, basic needs, early identification and treatment of parent and child BH issues, early childhood education, primary healthcare, etc.

Aligns with vision of a Child and Family Well Being System

- Reimagining of child and family serving systems





AB 2083 - Locally

Will embrace the full continuum of child and family serving systems

E4C VC will be the hub of its development

- Visioning, development of certain elements, cross systems leadership

Driven by family voice
